Part-time Commuter Study for Mexican and Canadian Students at UTPA

On August 26, 2002 the U.S. Immigration and Naturalization Service announced an interim rule to allow Mexican and Canadian commuter students to study on a part-time basis at schools located within 75 miles of the United States border. This new rule will clarify that Mexican or Canadian students who reside outside the United States and regularly commute across a land border to study may do so on a part-time basis within the F-1 or M-1 category. This regulation does not classify, as commuter students, those students who live in the U.S. during the week and return to Mexico on weekends and therefore they are not eligible for part-time study.

To qualify as a part-time commuter student the following requirements must be met:

1. must reside outside the U.S. and commute to school on class days
2. must be enrolled in a course of study that is leading to a degree
3. must attend an INS approved school less than 75 miles from the border
4. must be enrolled less than full-time; if you enroll full-time it is a violation of your status
5. must obtain an I-20, that indicates "Border Commuter Student" and provide financial documents to the International Student Advisement office every semester;
6. must obtain a valid F-1 visa for the U.S. Consulate

Please be aware part-time commuter students are not allowed any employment in the U.S. or receive any type of financial aid including the Mexican Tuition Waiver. For further information please contact the International Student Advisement Office at 956-381-2922.
