

**Criteria for Membership on the Graduate Faculty
Department of Modern Languages and Literatures**

Full Membership

1. Must be a tenured or tenure-track member of the faculty
2. Must hold a doctorate degree
3. Must have three refereed journal or book articles (or one book published by a reputable and refereed press) related to the discipline within the past five years.

Associate Membership (Associate status is for faculty who are just entering the academy and have not had the time to develop a professional dossier consistent with the requirements for full membership. Associate status may not be renewed.)

1. Must be a tenure-track member of the faculty
2. Must hold a doctorate degree
3. Must have one refereed journal or book article related to the discipline within the past three years or 3 presentations at recognized scholarly meetings or conferences within the past three years.

Special Membership (Special status is for scholars and/or artists in residence, post-doctoral fellows, professor emerita, lecturers or any other non-tenure or tenure track member of the instructional staff.)

1. Must have faculty status other than tenure or tenure track
2. Must hold a doctorate degree or other significant academic recognition (such as Nobel Prize, MacArthur Fellowship, Pulitzer Prize, Casa de las Américas, etc.)
3. Must have three refereed journal or book articles (or one book published by a reputable and refereed press) related to the discipline within the past five years.
