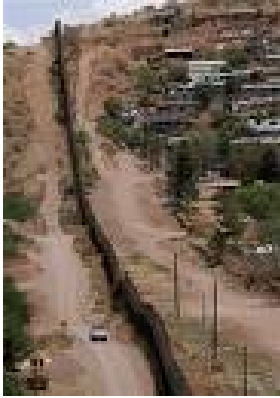


Collaborative PhD program in Spanish
