QUALIFICATIONS

TO QUALIFY FOR THE LOAN REPAYMENT PROGRAM, YOU MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA:

Submit a completed application to the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board by the priority deadline: October 1;

Received a doctoral degree from an accredited college or university;

Graduated from a Texas high school that at the time of graduation was

- a) one from which only 50% or less of the graduating class enrolled in an institution of higher education following graduation; or
- b) a low-income school;

OR

At the time of graduation from high school, resided in an area of Texas where the high school closest to his or her residence was

- a) one from which only 50% or less of the graduating class enrolled in an institution of higher education following graduation; or
- b) a low-income school;

Qualified for need-based financial assistance while enrolled in a graduate-level degree program;

Must *not* have been employed full-time as a faculty member or administrator with supervisory duties in an eligible institution for more than 12 months previous to the beginning of the academic year to which you are applying;

Have a full-time job offer or be negotiating a contract with an eligible institution for a position as either: a faculty member or as an administrator with supervisory duties;

Be a Texas Resident.

Do not let this opportunity pass you by! The priority deadline for applications is October 1st.

ABOUT THE DOCTORAL INCENTIVE LOAN REPAYMENT PROGRAM

The Doctoral Incentive Loan Repayment Program provides student loan repayment assistance as an incentive to attract members of underrepresented groups to full-time positions as faculty members or administrators at public or private higher education institutions in Texas.

ANNUAL LOAN AMOUNTS

The maximum annual repayment amount is \$20,000, with a \$100,000 maximum aggregate. Participation in the program is limited to five years.

ELIGIBLE LOANS

Loans must be evidenced by a promissory note which explicitly required that the proceeds be used to pay the costs incurred for attending a public or private higher education institution, and;

Loans cannot be repaid through the Border County Doctoral Faculty Education Loan Repayment Program administered by the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board, and;

Loans must not be in default.
